2:15 Request from the Department of Recreation Sciences regarding RCTX 2200:

- A. The Recreation Sciences department request that RCTX 2200, an online course, continue to receive credit for GE:HL (two credits) and GE:EX (one credit), as approved by GEIEC November 17th, 2020, the Faculty Senate on December 1, 2020 (RESOLUTION #20-7) and by the Chancellor on January 6, 2021. Delete "(Select at least one course in each area.)" from the Undergraduate Catalog, [General Education Program](#),
- B. If the above request is not approved, the Department of Recreation Sciences request the removal of the one credit-hour (GE:EX) credit from RCTX 2200, leaving RCTX 2200 with the two credit-hour (GE:HL) credit.

Motion (Kenny) to remove the **GE:EX** credit from RCTX 2200. During the discussion of the motion it was noted that ECU requires that students take two separate courses to fulfil both the health and the exercise General Education requirements. Granting one course credit for both was a mistake. After further discussion, a motion to call the question passed and the main motion passed.
