- 3. Announcements: Transfer Requests
 - a. The following transfer courses were approved for GE designations:

4. Business

- a. Designation Approval Request for Global Diversity:
 - i. ECON 3323 Costa Rica Agriculture Industry (Study Abroad) Summer I 2022 section only
 - ii. Rupp asked the committee to grant this course GD credit since it did not meet the automatic qualification for GD credit. This course is a 3 credit hour course, but was a nine day versus a fourteen day study abroad.
 - iii. Discussion:

 - 2. Martinez said the GEIEC Chair may have to write the Registrar and make a request for this specific section of ECON 3323 since this is a special topics course.
