## IX. New Business:

Consent agenda was discussed with the decision to follow the criteria used by the GCC the remainder of the semester and to make a decision at the end of the semester on how to use in UCC. The following information was shared:

In 9/4/2019 meeting Graduate Curriculum Committee decided to pursue Consent Agenda procedure for "Uncontroversial Curricular Proposal Packages"

According to this procedure, when assigned GCC reviewers consider a curriculum package to be uncontroversial or unproblematic, or they consider that the curriculum package is unexceptional apart from easily correctable issues, they may recommend to the Chair of the GCC that the package be placed on the Consent Agenda of the next GCC meeting.

- The Chair decides which packages will be placed on the Consent Agenda and distributes the associated documents with the regular agenda in time for GCC members to read and review them.
- At the beginning of the meeting, the Chair of the GCC will ask members if any Consent Agenda package should be moved to the regular agenda.
- If any member requests a package be moved to the regular agenda, it must be moved to the agenda of the subsequent GCC meeting[MA1].
- The Chair of the GCC moves to adopt all remaining packages on the Consent Agenda and, hearing no objections, will announce that all such packages have been approved.
- The minutes of the meeting will include the packages that were approved.

	Changes that are considered uncontroversial or unproblematic include:
	1) Editorial rewording of course objectives to make them suitable upper level courses,
	2) Editorial addition of clarifications such as "May be repeated [times]" for degree completion or for project completion,
	3) Addition of a prerequisite when program faculty have already voted and approved,
	4) Removal of a prerequisite when program faculty have already voted and approved, or
	5) Deletion of a banked course.
