Note: The committee discussed that the prerequisite course, RCTX 2230, was used inconsistently throughout the course forms. Because the course is now required for admission to the degree program, the faculty should determine if both "Declared RT major" and RCTX 2230 should be listed as prerequisites in all course forms or if only one should be used. The faculty presenters agreed to discuss this with their department faculty and update the forms. The committee requests consistency in the use of RCTX 2230 and/or "Declared RT major" in each course form and that the SOR is updated to match what is listed in the courses.

- 1. <u>Summary of Request</u>: See above statement regarding SOR.
- Revision of Existing Courses (Level I) <u>RCTX 3240</u>: In addition to the "Note," add to the justification "consent of instructor."
