

## **College of Engineering and Technology**

Department of Technology Systems

Mark Angolia introduced Leslie Pagliari and presented the package.

- 2. Revision of an Existing Degree (Level III) Industrial Distribution and Logistics, BS

Revisions to degree included changes in wording in the program description and changing the title from "Industrial Distribution and Logistics" to "Distribution and Logistics". Mark Angolia explained reasons for the proposed change including: prospective students' misunderstanding of the scope of the degree and changes in the field and degree to incorporate areas other than industrial distribution and logistics. Proposed title change is consistent with concentration in the Industrial Technology, BS, of Distribution and Logistics.

Prior to the meeting, faculty from the Technology Systems and Business met to discuss concerns about the proposed changes in the degree title and the catalog and program description language. Consensus between the departments was not reached about the degree title.

Prior to the meeting, wording in the program description was changed by Mark Angolia to the current catalog language related to the "opportunity to earn a business administration minor". Language in the degree in section 4 referencing Business Administration Minor and/or Electives was removed and the current catalog language was written to indicate what is currently in the catalog: Electives to complete requirements for graduation.

Faculty from the College of Business, Cody Chullen, Jon Kirchoff and Scott Dallana, voiced concerns about the package specifically related to the removal of "industrial" resulting in the Logistics and Distribution being too broad, having overlap with the Supply Chain Management, BSBA, and potential accreditation concerns.

Mark Angolia shared the curriculum revision history of the two degrees (please attach in files).

Ryan Kirk noted that in the Industrial Technology, BS the degree would list the concentration of Distribution and Logistics but only after the degree "Industrial Technology"

Stacy Weiss inquired about written concerns from the accreditors of business programs about the overlap. Faculty from the college of business explained in a previous business accreditation cycles Industrial Distribution and Logistics has been listed as an excluded program. 25% is the criteria for inclusion (note: even with a minor in business admin. degree is at 20% of credit hours in business). Industrial Distribution and Logistics is not in the college of business.

Ken Ferguson asked for clarification if opposition to the removal of the term "industrial" in the degree was a local issue at ECU only or if this was a national concern.

Jeni Parker moved to end discussion and call the question. John Collins seconded. One abstention. The rest approved.
