ACTIONS OF MEETING

Agenda Item: Ranking the Teaching Grants Proposals

<u>Discussion:</u> The committee decided to initially rank proposals by mean priority score (high – 3; medium – 2; low – 1) and then further sort proposals with the same mean priority scores by mean evaluation score (1 – 100).

Action Taken: A total of 34 proposals were discussed. Special notes were taken for each proposal as discussions were made. Proposals 20, 27, 32 and 33 were not scored and not included in the ranking due to one of the following reasons: 1) main proposal exceeded 4 pages; 2) proposal was inappropriate for a teaching grant (e.g., new course). The committee decided to recommend for funding 21 proposals with mean priority scores from 2.00 to 3.00. The committee approved the following overall ranking of the 21 recommended proposals as shown in the Table 1 below.
