## **ACTIONS OF MEETING**

## Agenda Item: Ranking the teaching grant proposals

Discussion: Committee discussed and ranked a total of 16 submitted proposals.

<u>Action Taken:</u> The proposals were discussed in numerical order. Notes were taken to provide feedback to proposals that were not considered for funding. The committee excluded 2 proposals from consideration due to specific reasons as shown in Table 1 below:

- The committee tried to maximize the number of proposals that can be funded.
- The committee ranked proposals 10, 1, 6, and 3 as the top four proposals to be funded.
- Proposal 11 has been also recommended for funding, but it will be funded from a separate budget by the Vice Chancellor for Health Sciences.

The remaining nine proposals may be recommended for funding depending on acceptance of awards for proposals 10, 1, 6, and 3. Those proposals are listed in Table 3 according to their ranking/ score.
