The subcommittee feels like it would be a good move to a proposed an engineering capstone project for a group of students to look at about 15 buildings and multiple parking lots for solar potential and doing a cost analysis on that. They drafted the proposal and met with the capstone coordinator on Monday March 27th to discuss this, then a capstone group would begin working on that project in the fall. It would be a year-long, two semester capstone project.
