As part of our continuous improvement process and in preparations for accreditation through Accreditation Board for Engineering and Technology (ABET), MS, Occupational Safety (MSOS) program is making some improvements in a few of its course. Two of the MSOS courses listed in Securities Studies are proposed to be changed (SAFT 6290 and SAFT 6410) as well. The changes are:

Current: SAFT 6290 Fire Protection and Prevention

Proposed: SAFT 6290 Fire Protection and Prevention and Emergency Management

"Emergency Management" is added to the course title and content. This course is also used by Security Studies. By adding "Emergency Management" the content of this course will be enhanced for both the Occupational Safety students as well as Security Studies students.

Current: SAFT 6410 System Safety Analysis

Proposed: SAFT 6410 System Safety and Risk Analysis

“Risk” is proposed to be added to truly reflect the title and content of this course in term of risk management and risk assessment, as related to safety.
